Kindergarten Enrolments 2023

We are currently taking enrolments for all students who are eligible to start school in 2023 in our Kindergarten classes. Children may be enrolled in Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five years of age on or before 31 July in that year. By law, all children must be enrolled in school by their sixth birthday.

When completing your online application, you have the opportunity to upload a copy of your child's birth certificate, statement of immunisation and proof of your current address.

If you have any friends or neighbours who may have a child ready to start school next year, please let them know that it is time to contact the school for further information and to commence the online enrolment process.

We had our first Kindergarten Information session for parents last week and we were extremely excited about the number of families we had attend. A big thanks to Mrs Anderson, Mr Boreland, Mrs Murch and Mrs Wootton for hosting the night and providing help and support for our incoming families. We look forward to meeting our new little friends. 😊

Confirmation Enrolment night Tuesday, 21st June, in Our Lady of the Rosary Parish Church from 7.00pm until 8.00pm, for Years 3 to 6.

PROCEDURE FOR PICKING UP KIDS FROM SCHOOL FOR PARENTS

- ◆ Notify the school that your child will be leaving early via class DOJO, and let the office know by phone call or email as sometimes teachers do not see the DOJO's in the day.
- ◆ Teachers to send child to the office 5 minutes before time specified by parent.
- ◆ Parent to call the office from the front gate...main gate on Chamberlain Road near the crossing, all other gates are locked.
- ◆ Call the office and let them know you are there; office staff will take student out to the top of the driveway. Parent is to give us a wave and we will let the child walk down the driveway to parent. Parents **MUST** make sure the gate is closed after their child.



If your child is sick and unable to walk down, you will be directed to drive up the driveway and come into the office to collect. Parents/Carers **MUST make sure they open and close the gates on arrival and open and close the gates on departure**....this is a safety issue.

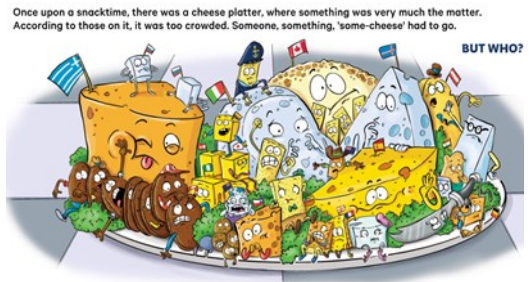
4B CLASSROOM NEWS

4B have had a lovely term and are powering through Term 2 like a rocket!



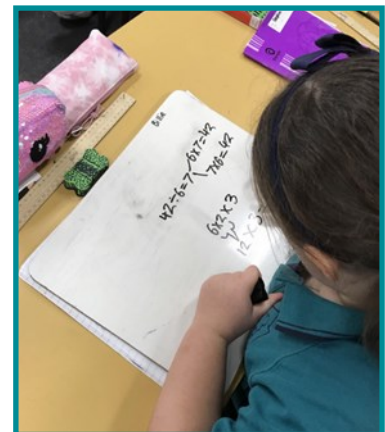
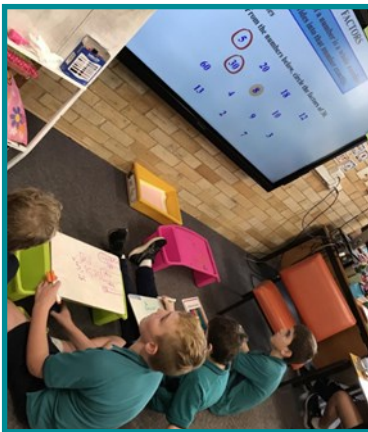

ENVIRONMENT CLUB NEWS!

The environment club have been working hard this term to collect, sort and recycle all the bread bags that Valley View Public School students have been bringing in.

We currently have five large boxes in the office foyer that are filling up fast! Our aim is to collect 25 Kg's of bread bags. Once full, we will return the boxes to Wonder rewards and trade them in for points to go towards new sports equipment. Wonder Rewards is partnered with REDcycle. REDcycle will empty the boxes, weigh the plastic and recycle the boxes once they have been returned.



The plastic is then baled and shipped to REPLAS who will turn it into the end product including benches, exercise circuits and bollards.

We have also been busy collecting and composting all the fruit and vegetable scraps from classrooms, the staffroom and the canteen. Our worms can't eat fast enough! Everyday at the end of eating time, the students collect the buckets, clean and return them to classrooms. We have some great plans for the next 6 months and can't wait to get things up and running. Stay tuned for more updates soon!

Without this paperwork you will not be permitted to transport other students in your car

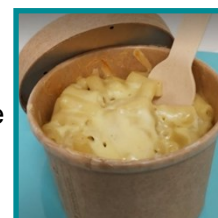

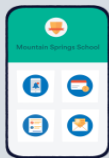
