Covid Update

Term 2 operational settings will remain largely the same as Term 1 with additional measures to support continuity of classroom learning. Isolation requirements for close contacts have changed. Staff and students can return to school as long as they have no symptoms and follow the close contact guidelines:

- ♦ They must notify the school and their outside of school hours care (OOSHC) provider if they are intending to return under this provision.
- They should conduct a daily rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days.
- They (if in a secondary school setting) must wear a mask indoors except when eating or exercising.
- Primary school students are recommended to wear a mask indoors (except when eating or exercising).
- No student or staff member identified as a close contact will be permitted to participate in overnight excursions, including school camps.

Any visitor to a school site who is a close contact is required to advise the school that they are a close contact before they come on site. These visitors should conduct a daily RAT and return a negative result before attending. They must also wear a mask indoors at all times. Schools should consider if the visit can be conducted virtually.

Additional supplies of RAT kits will be distributed to all schools to support staff and students identified as close contacts who are able to return.

NSW Health has updated the advice for students and staff returning to school after testing positive for COVID- 19 including the recommendation to wear a mask for an additional 3 days after the 7-day isolation period.

Intention to Apply: Year 5 Opportunity Class 2023

If you would like to have your child considered for a Year 5 Opportunity Class (OC) entry in 2023, you need to apply between Tuesday 26th April 2021 and Friday 13th May 2022. Students who have applied will sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on Thursday 28th July 2022. Please note OC classes are external to Valley View Public School.

NAPLAN

This term students in Years 3 and 5 will complete their NAPLAN assessments. This will be the first year that students from VVPS will complete their tests online. Students in Year 3 will complete a Reading, Conventions of Language and Numeracy test digitally and then writing will be a paper assessment. Year 5 will complete all tests online, including the writing. Teachers have been supporting students in preparing them for this assessment platform. The assessment window to implement NAPLAN runs from Tuesday 10th May to Friday 13th May. Please discuss this with your children and let them know that it is only one assessment on one day, there is no pressure and that all they need to do is their very best. NAPLAN provides the school with valuable information about the students' strengths and is used to guide schools about where teaching needs to be targeted for continuous improvement in literacy and numeracy. If your child is absent on the day of the assessment, they will be provided with the opportunity to complete a make-up assessment upon their return to school as long as it lies within dates of the assessment window as outlined above. 
