

2024 School Planning

The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 9 May 2024. Applications for Year 7 entry to selective high schools in 2025 are accepted from Monday 9 October 2023 to Monday 20 November 2023. You must apply before the closing date as no late applications will be considered. Please note there are no paper application forms. 
