To order for another child, click "Order for Another Child" and then click "Add Via Child Details" and enter their sumame and date of birth. Family/Sibling Photos are also available. All Family/Sibling orders must be placed by 11pm the day before photo day.


To log in to your students reading record at home, they simply use the username and password that they use at school. Books which have been read at home this year can then be added to the record.

What does Belonging look like at Valley View Public School?


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Week 9 in PBL K - 2 are learning about being a good friend.


